
Case study Gardener Schools Group

Results

The Gardeners used the Ravenscourt Park Preparatory School model to open a second school in 2004 - Kew Green Preparatory School.

The business has since continued to expand under the leadership of the Gardener's son, Theo Brehony. Kew House School, the Group's first senior school, opened in September 2013, with Maida Vale School following suit in 2020. Most recently, in 2022, the Group opened Kew Green Nursery to support Kew Green Preparatory School in providing education for children aged 2-11 years.

Over the past 30+ years Warrener Stewart has helped Gardener Schools Group grow from a start-up family business with nil income, to a £35 million business employing nearly 350 people and educating around 1,500 children.
